### COMMANDER'S REPORT

There is a proposed bylaw change being made, and it is:

#### ARTICLE VIII

#### Section 6. Imposition of disciplinary action by the Club Committee.

The Legion "family" members may have their club privileges suspended upon a proper showing of cause to the Club Committee. Charges can range from physical to verbal harassment of employees to fellow patrons; any use of vulgarity in the club, fraudulent behavior and/or conduct unbecoming of a member of the Legion "family".

I also review the daily reports and have indicated on the list those cards that have been used, and eventually this list will be turned in to the Company that runs the program and they will be canceling all card numbers that have not been used. In short, if you have more than one card, please surrender those excess cards to the bar or to the office. It is not fair to those members who have abided by the rules and regulations for those members who have chose to ignore the rules and regulations to possess more than one card from the Post. Furthermore, the only individuals who can have a card is a member; however, if your

spouse or friend wishes to use your card, you must be in the building and **YOU**, as the member, must sign the redemption slip.

The Pull Tab machine falls under the same guidelines. Only members can redeem the tickets. This is not our rules but the State's, as this is a State ran program under the Lottery.

No final decision has been reached at this point.

**IF YOU HAVE MAILED IN YOUR DUES AND HAVE RECEIVED YOUR CARD, BUT STILL RECEIVE ANOTHER NOTICE FROM NATIONAL REGARDING YOUR DUES, JUST THROW IT AWAY, AS YOU FELL BETWEEN TWO MAILING CYCLES. I HAVE TO SEND THE DUES TO DEPARTMENT, WHO, IN TURN, FORWARD THEM TO NATIONAL, SO IT MAY TAKE SEVERAL WEEKS TO GET EVERYTHING RECORDED AT NATIONAL.**

If you have a friend that wishes to join The American Legion or The Sons of The American Legion, have them fill out an application and bring a copy of their military discharge papers to the Post. For the SAL and Auxiliary, if the sponsor is still living, they must be a member of The American Legion or if deceased, the sponsor must have been eligible for membership in The American Legion. To be eligible for membership in the SAL, only the sons, grandsons, adopted sons or stepsons are eligible, not brothers, nephews, etc. For the Auxiliary, the applicant's relationship to the veteran must be a mother, wife, daughter, sister, granddaughter, great-granddaughter, grandmother or the veteran herself.

Just a reminder, the Post meetings are the third Thursday of the month. We extend a hearty welcome to the Legionnaires to attend these meetings, as they can be informative at times and it takes the membership to approve any action taken by the Executive Committee.
